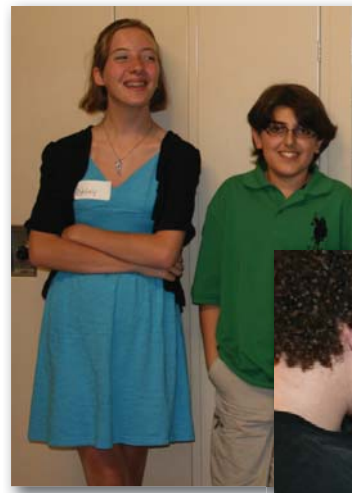

WHAT HAVE THE STUDENTS LEARNED?

Since the retreat on June 17th at Mt. Scott Community Center the following students: (Hanna, Halley, Anthony, Reuben, Luke, Carl, Sierra, Alex, and Jerry) have learned team building and the importance of being creative while addressing film making. The summer skill building meetings on July 7th, 14th, and 21st have allowed additional students: (Hope, Ashley, Rossteen, Alex, and Dorsey) to join in and learn about addiction and the key components of film making.

On July 14th, two impressive guest speakers presented to the students. East Precinct Sergeant John Scruggs of the Portland Police Bureau, presented film footage of personal interviews with local drug addicts. Students learned the background stories of these individuals and got a clear look into the hard lives of those that chose to turn to drugs. Our second guest speaker was, Dan Schaefer, a local storyboard artist whose work includes the Teenage Mutant Ninja Turtles. Mr. Schaefer gave students a glimpse at what it is like to work within the film industry.

This drug prevention and film making knowledge will assist the students during production week, where students will be creating their final film. The premiere will be on September 9th at the Academy Theater.
