Camarena Educational Foundation, an all-volunteer, nonprofit, public benefit corporation dedicated to eradicating drug abuse nationwide. Mika is the proud mother of Enrique, Daniel and Erik.

Senator Margaret Carter- first elected to the Oregon House in 1984 and in 2000 to her first term in the Oregon Senate. As a legislator, she has helped to create the Oregon Convention Center, a permanent state Head Start Program, the Oregon Youth Conservation Corps, and the bill to establish a state holiday to honor Dr. Martin Luther King Jr., advocacy for emerging minority and women businesses, and funding for the Portland Public Schools.
